



Makeup bag

Cheerful daisies frolic across this toilet bag, as well as the matching makeup bag. Because they're see-through you'll be able to tell at first glance if everything's been packed. These little bags don't even need to be turned right-side out after sewing, which can be a somewhat tricky process with plastic film.

Size approx. 18 x 11 cm (7" x 4 3/8")

Materials:

- 15 cm (6") daisy plastic film
- 15 cm (6") white tablecloth film
- 22 cm (9") zipper
- zigzag foot with sliding sole no. 52, zipper foot with sliding sole no. 54 if wished

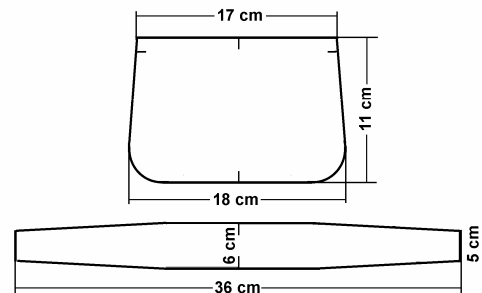
Important:

Read tips on working with plastic film before beginning project.

Cutting out:

2 x bag sides from daisy plastic film
1 x bag base from white plastic film

- 2 strips in white approx. 38 cm (15") long and 1.5 cm (1/2") wide (incl. seam allowance)
- 1 strip in white approx. 50 cm (20") long and 1.5 cm (1/2") wide (incl. seam allowance)
- 1 piece in white approx. 5 cm (2") long and 5 cm (2") wide (incl. seam allowance)



Instructions:

1. Turn under seam allowances of end seams of base and stitch.
2. Pin on side section to base section wrong sides together, making sure that the center and ends meet up with the appropriate markings on the pattern pieces. Sew with large stitches from bagside side. Snip seam allowances around curves and cut even if wished. Fold one 38-cm (15")-long strip in half lengthwise and place previous seam in between. Stitch tape over seam in one go. Sew other side of bag in exact same way. Trim top ends of tape flush.
3. Fold zipper under at top ends and sew to top edge of bag wrong sides together. Now fold long strip in half lengthwise, and starting at bottom end of zipper, wrap around zipper tape and top edge of bag and sew. Sew over the turned-under end of zipper and over the edge of the bag, leaving a 5-cm (2")-long loop, and edge the zipper continuously in exact same way on other side.
4. Fold small piece of white film in half, sew both sides and turn inside-out. Slip over end of zipper and stitch.
