



## Toilet bag with ribbons

Size approx. 26 x 18 x 6 cm (10 1/4" x 7" x 2 3/8")

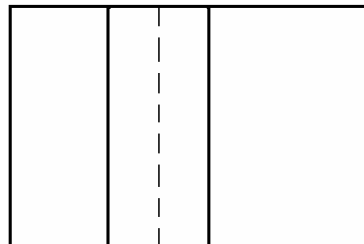
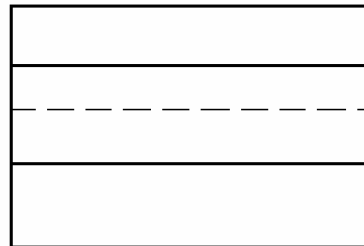
### Machines and accessories:

This toilet bag was sewed on a BERNINA virtuosa.

### Materials:

- 25 cm (10") clear plastic film
- Remnant of white film
- Cardboard the size of base, approx. 26 x 6 cm (10 1/4" x 2 3/8")
- 2 x 60 cm (23 1/2") each gift-wrap ribbons, for example with stripes and flowers, each 4 cm (1 1/2") wide
- 25-cm (10") with zipper
- Zigzag foot with sliding sole no. 52, and zipper foot with sliding sole no. 54 if wished

The top sketch shows the front of the bag, the bottom shows the back.



### Important:

Don't forget seam allowances!

### Cutting out clear plastic film:

- 2 x bag sides, each 32 x 22 cm (12 1/2" x 8 3/4")
- 1 strip 9,5 x 32 cm (3 3/4" x 12 1/2") and 1 strip 9,5 x 22 cm (3 3/4" x 8 3/4"). Cut no seam allowance for width (9.5 cm (3 3/4")).

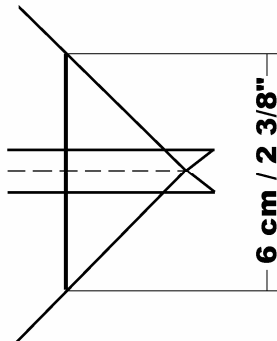
### Cutting out white film:

- 2 pieces 6 x 3 cm (2 3/8" x 1 1/4") without seam allowance
- For the base insert, from white film, 26 x 12 cm (10 1/4" x 4 3/4")

### Instructions:

1. Topstitch film strips on front approx 5 cm (2") from top edge, as shown in drawing above. Pull through ribbon, and stitch center (dashed line) also. Insert second ribbon and topstitch bottom edge.
2. On back of bag, topstitch film strip approx. 8.5 cm (3 3/8") from left edge. Continue working as on front side.
3. Now work in zipper in center along top edges. Fold the small white pieces of film into squares, wrong sides inward. Stitch edges together. Stitch squares to ends of zipper.
4. Open zipper slightly and sew bag all around.

5. Place all side seams in the corners on an adjoining base seam in each case, and topstitch 6 cm (2 3/8") at a 90° angle – see drawing. This gives the base, and the whole cube shape.



6. Carefully turn bag inside out and press into shape.
7. Compare size of cardboard once more with size of base. Wrap cardboard in white film and sew along open edges.
